
Logging In

Select History to view your recent games.

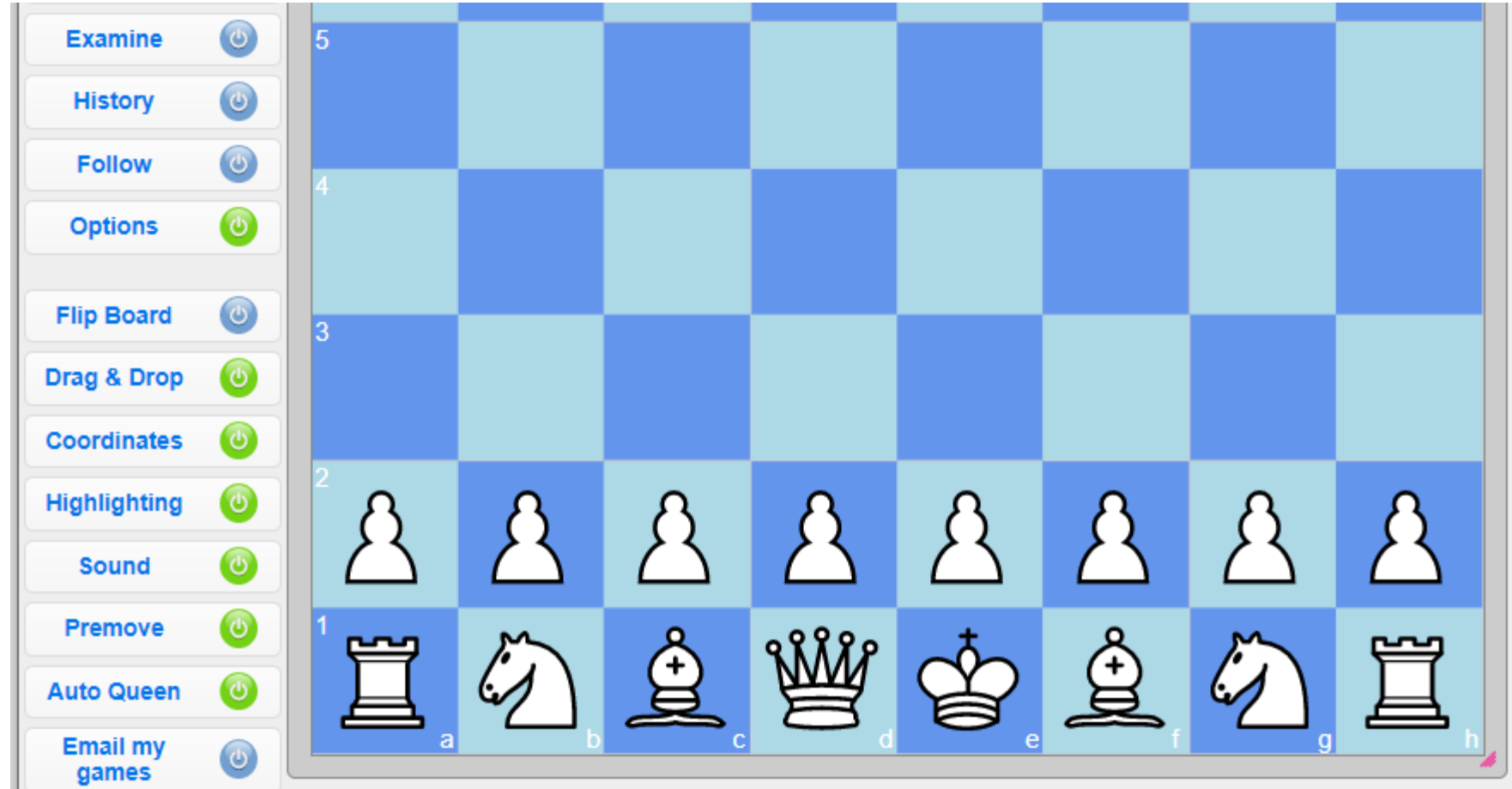
Select Follow to follow another player, teacher, or coach.
